VOLUNTEER APPRECIATION WEEK


WHEREAS, in the proud tradition of our rich heritage, James City County volunteers continue to be our most valuable resource; and

WHEREAS, volunteerism offers opportunities to every citizen to participate in their government in order to meet community needs; and


