
CHESAPEAKE AND POTOMAC TELEPHONE COMPANIES CONTIGUOUS CALLING PLAN

WHEREAS, on August 16, 1993, the Board of Supervisors requested that Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Companies amend its contiguous calling proposal filed with the State Corporation to include the 564 and 566 Toano telephone exchanges; and

WHEREAS, the proposed contiguous calling plan does not include the 566 Toano exchange; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to unify all of James City County and provide equivalent telephone service to all County residences.
