


RESOLUTION

DEED TO CONVEY PROPERTY TO THE WILLIAMSBURG-JAMES CITY COUNTY

PUBLIC SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of James City County, following a public hearing held on June 20, 1994, is of the opinion that certain real property located in the Berkeley District should be conveyed to the Williamsburg-James City County Public Schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of James City County, Virginia, that Perry M. DePue, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, is hereby authorized and directed to execute a Special Warranty Deed, dated June 20, 1994, conveying an 80.01-acre parcel located in the Berkeley District to the Williamsburg-James City County Public Schools, said property to be used as the site for a new high school.
