 - 1. For each sign, the applicant shall submit a sign foundation landscaping and lighting plan to be approved by the Director of Planning to ensure compliance with Code Section 20-68.
 - 2. The signs and attached fences shall be placed in areas approved to be cleared in order to construct entrances into the proposed developments.
