RESOLUTION

JAMES CITY COUNTY LIBRARY - FY 1996 TRANSITION

- WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of James City County is constructing the James City County Library (JCCL) in Norge, and the Williamsburg Regional Library (WRL) will begin operating the facility in July 1996; and
- WHEREAS, operating spending needs to begin in the several months before the planned opening to prepare the library, stock and catalog the books, and train new employees, at an estimated cost of \$150,000; and
- WHEREAS, funds exist within the existing project capital budget to pay for these expenditures.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Supervisors of James City County, Virginia, authorizes the transfer of up to \$150,000 from the Capital Project Budget for the James City County Library to reimburse actual spending incurred to open the library; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the transfer of funds anticipates that up to ten full-time equivalent positions may be created and filled, prior to April 1, 1996, to make the opening possible.
