CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM - SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has previously adopted a five-year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) without identifying specific projects for funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of James City County, Virginia, hereby adopts the FY 97 Capital Budget for Schools, as recommended by vote of the School Board, totaling \$7,875,573, and consistent with the five-year CIP as follows:
