**APRIL 13-19, 1997**


WHEREAS, County government traces its roots to the English shire of a thousand years ago, serving as the citizen's local government voice since its inception; and

WHEREAS, James City County is one of the eight original shires created in America; and


WHEREAS, when the Federal government was formed, the framers of the Constitution chose to provide states the freedom to create County governments; and
