

**RESOLUTION**


**CROP DISASTER AREA**

WHEREAS, weather conditions have created a drought seriously affecting the yields of summer crops and the available resources of the County are insufficient to cope with the effects of the drought; and


WHEREAS, the cost of production of these crops is greater than the value of the commodity in the marketplace.
