- WHEREAS, to encourage greater friendship and understanding, the people of James City County and Ipswich agree, in a gesture of friendship and goodwill, to collaborate for the mutual benefit of our communities by exploring educational, economic, and cultural opportunities; and
- WHEREAS, we agree to support and encourage opportunities for mutually beneficial practical exchanges in the fields of business, arts, culture, and tourism.
