AUTHORIZATION TO INCREASE PART-TIME ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER

FROM PART-TIME TO FULL-TIME POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the present staffing of two full-time, one part-time and two on-call Officers does not meet the needs of the Department; and

WHEREAS, making the part-time Animal Control Officer full-time will enable Animal Control to have a more efficient work schedule that will reduce overtime, stand-by, and recruitment costs; and

WHEREAS, reducing overtime and stand-by hours should have a positive impact on staff health and morale; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in the FY 02 Animal Control budget to fund increasing this position from part-time to full-time.


