RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR HOUSE BILL 2

TRANSPORTATION FUNDING APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, in an effort to ensure the best use of limited transportation funds, the Commonwealth has established a new transportation funding formula, via House Bill 1887, and prioritization process, via House Bill 2 (HB2) and House Bill 1887; and

WHEREAS, there are two main pathways to funding within the HB2 process – the Construction District Grant Program and the High-Priority Projects Program; and

WHEREAS, James City County recently adopted its update to the Comprehensive Plan, Toward 2035: Leading the Way, which included transportation as a priority focus area; and

WHEREAS, the adopted Comprehensive Plan identified almost \$217 million in needed investment in the County's transportation system.


