## COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA STANDARD AGREEMENT

Contract Number: 260-16837-01
PARKING SPACE FUNDING SUPPLEMENT, CLEARING/GRUBBING AND EROSION
AND SEDIMENT CONTROL

This contract entered into this 1<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2006 between James City County. General Services Department, 113 Tewning Road, Williamsburg, VA hereinafter called the "County" and Commonwealth of Virginia, State Board For Community Colleges, Virginia Community College System, 101 North 14<sup>th</sup> Street, Richmond, Virginia 23219 hereinafter called the "Purchasing Agency or Owner".

WITNESSETH that the County and the Purchasing Agency, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and agreements herein contained, agree as follows:

That the County, with supplemental local trust and agency funding from the Purchasing Agency, shall provide to the Purchasing Agency services to construct 50 parking spaces, to ensure construction of a total of 750 parking spaces per the Declaration of Restrictive Covenants and Agreements between James City County and the State Board for Community Colleges, executed July 14, 2006.

In addition, the County shall provide to the Purchasing Agency services to provide clearing and grubbing and erosion and sediment control measures for the Thomas Nelson Community College's Historic Triangle building site of 4.3 acres on the Warhill Tract property in James City County, scheduled for acquisition by gift from James City County to the State Board for Community Colleges in association with the following project:

Thomas Nelson Community College,
 Construct Historic Triangle Campus, Project Code 260-16837

SCOPE OF PARKING SPACES: The Purchasing Agency agrees to provide supplemental funding for all work necessary to construct the 50 parking spaces (total 750 to include ADA spaces). In consideration for said services, the Purchasing Agency shall pay to James City County, a lump sum amount of \$60,000, per the James City County proposal dated Normal 2006, upon substantial completion and acceptance of work by the Purchasing Agency.

SCOPE OF CLEARING AND GRUBBING and ROUGH GRADING SERVICES: The County shall provide the Basic Services included in Proposal received from James City County to the Purchasing Agency, dated La James 2006 for the lump sum amount of \$98,557.40 to provide all work necessary to clear, grub, and rough grade the 4.3 acre project site per engineering plans prepared by AES Consulting Engineers, under separate contract with the Purchasing Agency. Lump sum payment for clearing, grubbing and rough grading services, is due upon substantial completion and acceptance of work by the Purchasing Agency. Acceptance of work shall not be unreasonably withheld by the Purchasing Agency.

PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE: From December 01, 2006 and no later than June 1, 2007.

#### **SCOPE OF SERVICES - STATE**

#### L ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING

A. Virginia Water Protection Permit

- 1. Prepare and submit a Joint Permit Application (JPA) for a Virginia Water Protection (VWP) Permit 1 to the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to obtain authorization for jurisdictional impacts to the isolated wetland on the TNCC Warhill Tract Site.
- 2. Provide a narrative description detailing the purpose and need for the project to justify the proposed jurisdictional area impacts.
- 3. Compile a detailed wetland impacts summary under the proposed plan in an effort to demonstrate avoidance and minimization or impact justification.
- 4. Provide required drawings depicting the proposed impacts in relation to the site development.
- 5. Reply to Requests for Additional Information posed by DEQ as a result of the permit application.
- 6. Provide an analysis of mitigation alternatives sufficient to satisfy the compensatory mitigation requirements commensurate with the permit.
- 7. Negotiate issuance of the permit from DEQ.
- 8. Submit Fee Form and Fee of \$800 required for the permit being requested.
- 9. Negotiate compensatory mitigation with DEQ and provide payment for agreed upon mitigation.
- 10. Provide permit compliance services associated with the requested permit including construction monitoring and reporting, flagging of non-impacted wetland areas within 50 feet of impact areas and coordination with DEQ.

**ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES FEE\*** COMPENSATORY MITIGATION COST\*\* \$ 35,000,00 \$ 49,400.00

- \* This fee proposal is based on the assumption that impacts to wetlands will be between one-tenth and one-half of an acre and that DEQ will issue a VWP-1. In the event that any of the above conditions change, this scope of services and fee proposal will need to be revisited.
- \*\* The compensatory mitigation estimate is based on the following information:

Current survey mapping provided to Timmons Group from others indicates 0.38 acres of isolated wetlands confirmed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (COE) COE #04-R3274 within the development footprint of the proposed improvements. Compensatory mitigation will be achieved through purchase of wetland credits at an approved private wetland mitigation bank. Mitigation for the proposed impacts will be on a 2:1 basis (as required by the permit), resulting in 0.76 credits required for purchase. Private wetland mitigation banks are market driven, and fluctuate with respect to credit availability and costs. Current price ranges for wetland credits ranger from \$55,000 to \$75,000 per credit. Compensatory mitigation cost basis is as follows (0.76 x \$65,000 = \$49,400.00)
