Mr. McGlennon asked about the cost of maintaining independent water systems. He stated that the regular James City Service Authority (JCSA) customers may be subsidizing independent water system customers.

Mr. Foster stated that was correct.

Mr. McGlennon stated that he would like information about adjusting the upfront payment required for independent water systems in order to help defray the costs of providing water to the systems.

Mr. Foster stated that about a year ago he submitted a report indicating that the current \$4,000-per-lot developer fee for independent water systems was roughly half of what was necessary to cover the expense.

SUBJECT: Abandonment of Sewer Easement – 313 Littletown Quarter

Attached for your consideration is a resolution to authorize the abandonment of a 100±-square-foot portion of a sewer easement located on 313 Littletown Quarter (Parcel No. 5040600313). Littletown Quarter is a single-townhome complex located in Kingsmill.

When the structure was constructed in the early 1980s, a portion/corner of the townhouse was built over the easement. Having the structure over the easement can cause challenges when the ownership of the building transfers. The James City Service Authority (JCSA) has determined that abandoning the portion of the easement encumbered by the structure will not impair its ability to maintain the sewer line located within the easement. In addition, the property owner has agreed to a provision in the Deed to hold the JCSA harmless for damage caused by an adjacent sewer line repair.

After receiving public comment and closing the public hearing, staff recommends approval of the attached resolution authorizing the General Manager to sign the appropriate documents abandoning the 100± square feet of sewer easement encumbered by the townhome located at 313 Littletown Quarter.

#### 313 LITTLETOWN QUARTER
