SUBJECT: Contract Award – CCTV Inspection of Gravity Sanitary Sewer Pipes Services

A Request for Proposal (RFP) was solicited from qualified firms to provide CCTV inspection of gravity sanitary sewer pipes services, as determined necessary by the James City Service Authority (JCSA). This CCTV work is an integral part of the JCSA's compliance of its Consent Order with The Department of Environmental Quality.

The RFP process was used to identify the best vendors and product match, which will ensure superior video resolution and quality of work to enable the JCSA to make determinations regarding the integrity and condition of the pipes before structural problems emerge, thereby incurring an overall lower cost to maintain and clean the pipe system. The contract is also in place to ensure compliance with the Department of Environmental Quality consent order.

It was determined by the review team that the best value will be obtained from a contractor(s) with proven experience inspecting and cleaning gravity sanitary sewer pipes offered at a fair and reasonable price.

Eight firms responded to the RFP by describing their interest, qualifications, project approach, and experience in performing similar work. A team of staff members representing the JCSA and the James City County Purchasing Division evaluated the proposals submitted by eight firms and selected the three topranked firms to continue the evaluation process. One firm was selected to be awarded a contract. The contract has an initial term of two years with the option of up to four one-year renewals. The RFP included cooperative procurement provisions allowing other entities to use the contracted firms if they so choose.

The firm selected and recommended for contract award is as follows:

• Prism Contractors & Engineers, Inc.

Staff recommends approval of the attached resolution awarding a contract to the firm listed above.
