1. James City Service Authority Petty Cash Fund

RESOLUTION

JAMES CITY SERVICE AUTHORITY PETTY CASH FUND

- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the James City Service Authority has established a petty cash fund for the purpose of emergency and miscellaneous expenses; and
- WHEREAS, the currently established amount of \$50.00 has become insufficient to meet the Service Authority's petty cash needs.

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the James City Service Authority, James City County, Virginia, authorizes the petty cash fund to be increased to \$100.00.
- Conveyance of Easement to James City County

RESOLUTION

TO CONVEY 20-FOOT DRAINAGE AND UTILITY EASEMENT

ACROSS RICHARDSON-MEADOWS TRACT TO JAMES CITY COUNTY

- WHEREAS, the James City Service Authority holds a 20-foot drainage and utility easement across a portion of the Richardson-Meadows Tract owned by James City County; and
- WHEREAS, the Authority has no present or future need for such easement.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the James City Service Authority hereby authorizes its Chairman to execute a Deed of Easement, attached hereto and incorporated by reference, relinquishing a 20-foot drainage and utility easement to James City County as shown on a plat entitled, "Plat Showing 20-foot Drainage and Utility Easement as Designated on a Certain Plat Entitled "Subdivision of a Portion of Parcel "A" Richardson-Meadows Tract" for Conveyance From James City Service Authority To James City County", made by Rouse-Sirine Associates, Ltd., Virginia Beach, Virginia, dated July 20, 1987.

- Water Extension Agreement Rampart Packaging
- Water Extension Agreement McLaws Circle
 - Mr. Wanner reported that all fees have been paid by the developers.
 - Mr. Edwards asked if the water supplier issue might be disputed.
- Mr. Wanner replied that the two parcels abut the Service Authority waterline and the Authority will provide water to the parcels, while the Newport News line will provide fire flow and water for the sprinkler system.
 - Mr. Mahone asked if there might be an engineering problem.
 - Mr. Wanner replied in the negative.
- Mr. Taylor made a motion to approve the water extension agreements, Board Consideration Items #1 and #2.

The agreements were approved by a unanimous voice vote.

CITY OF NEWPORT NEWS WATER EXTENSION AGREEMENT

- WHEREAS, the Lawson Group, Ltd., has prepared plans for the Rampart Packaging Addition, a development in the Busch Corporate Center; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Newport News has prepared a water extension agreement for the extension of a City water main to serve this development; and
- WHEREAS, all required fees have been paid by the developer.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the James City Service Authority, James City County, Virginia, does hereby authorize and direct the Chairman and Secretary to execute the Newport News Water Extension Agreement on behalf of the Service Authority.

CITY OF NEWPORT NEWS WATER EXTENSION AGREEMENT

- WHEREAS, Busch Properties, Inc., has prepared plans for the Busch Corporate Center McLaws Circle Connection; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Newport News has prepared a water extension agreement for the extension of the City water main to serve this street; and
- WHEREAS, all testing fees and inspection fees have been paid by Busch Properties, Inc.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the James City Service Authority, James City County, Virginia, does hereby authorize and direct the Chairman and Secretary to execute the Newport News Water Extension Agreement on behalf of the Service Authority.

3. City of Williamsburg Sewer Connection - 2229 Richmond Road

Mr. Wanner stated that the City of Williamsburg adopted a resolution requesting the James City Service Authority to permit G-Square, Incorporated, to connect an existing commercial building and addition to the service main along Richmond Road. He noted that the developer plans to extend the existing building, which will eliminate the septic system. He stated that the existing main has the capacity for the proposed connection.

Mr. Wanner further stated that the developer would be required to pay the replacement capacity charge of \$3,980, and that the parcel is located in both the City of Williamsburg and York County.

Mr. Edwards inquired if there were similar situations in the area.

Mr. Wanner said that he was unaware of any such parcels, and that most of the other parcels have access to the Hampton Roads Sanitation District line.

Mr. Taylor made a motion to approve the resolution.

The resolution was approved by a unanimous voice vote.

RESOLUTION

CITY OF WILLIAMSBURG SEWER CONNECTION

- WHEREAS, G-Square, Incorporated, has requested permission to connect their property, consisting of an existing office building and a proposed addition, located at 2229 Richmond Road, Williamsburg, to the James City Service Authority sanitary sewer located on Richmond Road; and
- WHEREAS, this connection has been authorized by the City Council, City of Williamsburg; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council, City of Williamsburg, has petitioned the James City Service Authority Board of Directors to give favorable consideration to this request.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the James City Service Authority, James City County, Virginia, does hereby approve the connection of an existing commercial building with an addition, located at 2229 Richmond Road, Williamsburg, Virginia, to the James City Service Authority sanitary sewer system. This approval is subject to the payment of all appropriate availability and quarterly fees and the payment for the capacity replacement charge and the installation of a service connection in accordance with Service Authority regulations.

4. York County Sewer Connection - 525 Mooretown Road

Mr. Wanner stated that in 1985 the York County Board of Supervisors adopted a resolution requesting the James City Service Authority permit Mr. Frederick D. Hirsh to connect his property to the sanitary sewer main along Mooretown Road.

Mr. Wanner further stated that with the York County approval, Mr. Hirsh assumed he was authorized to proceed with the project. When Mr. Hirsh came in to pay connection fees, the Service Authority advised him that the James City Board of Directors had not approved the connection.

Mr. Wanner concluded that the capacity is available, and the applicant is prepared to pay the fees. Staff recommends approval of the resolution.

Mr. Edwards asked if steps were being taken to discourage future assumptions of approval by applicants.

Mr. Wanner replied that agreement had been reached that all such resolutions would be handled by the Public Works Department in York County.

Mr. DePue made a motion to approve the resolution.

The resolution was approved by a unanimous voice vote.

RESOLUTION

YORK COUNTY SEWER CONNECTION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Frederick D. Hirsh has requested permission to connect his property, consisting of an existing single-family dwelling, an existing cabinet shop and a proposed warehouse at 525 Mooretown Road, York County, to the James City Service Authority Sanitary Sewer located on Mooretown Road; and
- WHEREAS, this request has been authorized by the York County Board of Supervisors; and
- WHEREAS, the York County Board of Supervisors has petitioned the James City Service Authority Board of Directors to give favorable consideration to this request.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the James City Service Authority, James City County, Virginia, does hereby approve the connection of one single-family dwelling and one cabinet shop with warehouse located at 525 Mooretown Road, York County, to the James City Service Authority Sanitary Sewer System. This approval is subject to the payment of all appropriate availability and quarterly fees, and the payment of the capacity replacement charge and the installation of a service connection in accordance with Service Authority Regulations.

Mr. Mahone noted that the Service Authority's Second Quarterly Report in the Reading File was very helpful, and he appreciated the staff's efforts in compiling the report.

Mr. Taylor made a motion to adjourn.


