B. MINUTES

Mr. Norment reconvened the Board for a Comprehensive Plan update work session at 5:35 p.m.

The Board and staff discussed the proposed Stonehouse designation and Richmond Road Corridor; made no changes to the proposed Jamestown Road Ferry Approach and Crawford property designations; and, by a straw vote, approved alternatives received from staff to Cokes Lane area, Williamsburg-Jamestown Airport and Anderson's Corner designations, and approved Stonehouse mixed use area.


By straw vote, the Board approved the Comprehensive Plan recommended by the Planning Commission, with revisions discussed during the work sessions.
