B. PUBLIC HEARING

1. Proposed Real Property Tax Rate FY 94

Mr. John E. McDonald, Manager of Financial and Management Services, stated that if approved, the proposed real property tax rate would be \$0.75 per \$100 of assessed value, an increase of \$.02 from \$0.73 per \$100 of assessed value.

Ms. Knudson opened the public hearing.
