

A request was made for comparison of the County's personal property tax rate with rates of other jurisdictions.

The Board also requested a presentation on the sidewalk program, a written report on stormwater management plan and computer replacement program, and indicated it would focus on the Fire Department, Solid Waste and Recreation budgets after the presentations of the School Board and Library Board at Thursday's work session.
