

276 AT A BUDGET WORK SESSION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF JAMES CITY, VIRGINIA, HELD ON THE 21ST DAY OF APRIL, NINETEEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR, AT 7:00 P.M. IN THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT CENTER BOARD ROOM, 101 MOUNTS BAY ROAD, JAMES CITY COUNTY, VIRGINIA.

Ms. Jeanne Zeidler, Chairperson, Williamsburg-James City County School Board presented the school budget, with participation of Dr. Gayden Carruth and David Papenfuse of the school staff.

Ms. Ursula Murden, Ms. Linda Massie, and Ms. Nancy Archibald presented the library operating budget and asked for additional funding for salaries and for increases in hospitalization, materials and service costs.

Mr. John T. P. Horne and Mr. Wayland Bass made a presentation on the sidewalk program. By a straw vote of 5-0, the Board agreed to replace Longhill Road project (Lafayette High School to C. T. Lewis store), estimated cost \$63,000, with Longhill Road project (Burton Woods to Centerville Road). These savings, along with a Longhill Road project shortened by developer constructed expansion (Ashbury Road to the Mews), were to be calculated and presented at the work session on Monday, April 25, 1994.

Mr. Richard Miller, Fire Chief, presented the Fire Department budget; Mr. Anthony Conyers and Mr. Needham Cheely presented the Parks and Recreation budgets; and, Mr. Larry Foster presented highlights of the Solid Waste budget.

Mr. DePue made a motion to recess until 7:00 p.m., Monday, April 25, 1994.
