Mr. Sisk called the work session to order and welcomed the Williamsburg Regional Library Board members.

Board and Library Board members discussed the proposed library budget requests.

Board and staff members discussed Capital Improvement Projects and contributions to outside agencies.

Mr. Taylor made a motion to decrease Parks and Recreation operation, Parks and Recreation capital and Community Services by \$100,000 respectively.

The straw vote failed 1-4.

Mr. DePue made a motion to increase contribution to Tourism Bureau with condition that if matching funds were not received from the State that the contribution would be reduced.

The straw vote passed 5-0.

Mr. Magoon made a motion to increase landscaping by \$15,000 in Capital Improvement Project.

The straw vote passed 4-1.

Mr. Magoon made a motion to increase contribution to Jamestown/Yorktown Foundation by \$4,000.

The straw vote passed 3-2.

Mr. Edwards made a motion to increase the tax rate by one-cent to fund acquisition of greenspace.

The straw vote passed 4-1.

Mr. Sisk made a motion to recess until 7:00 p.m., Thursday, April 25, 1996, for a budget work session.
