The straw vote passed 3-2.

By consensus, the Board agreed to changes on the errata list, except for the change in the amount contributed to the Capital Improvement Project budget to reduce debt, which would be the fund balance after any other changes to the budget and revenues.

Mr. Sisk made a motion to increase contribution to Court Appointed Special Advocate program by \$2,000.

The straw vote failed 1-4.

Mr. Edwards made a motion to delete the proposed County marketing sponsorship at the Michelob Championship Golf Tournament.

The straw vote failed 2-3.

Mr. McGlennon made a motion to increase the Library's budget by \$110,000 to fund Friday openings and address compensation at the lower end of Library's salary scale.

The straw vote passed 4-1.

Mr. Edwards made a motion to recess until 4:00 p.m., Monday, April 27, 1998, for a budget work session.
