a. Sale of 3600 LaGrange Parkway

Mr. Taylor introduced Mr. Scott Albertson of BP Solarex. Mr. Taylor briefly stated that Solarex will be purchasing the IDA shell building at 3600 LaGrange Parkway, subject to IDA action.

b. BP Solarex Expansion

Mr. Scott Albertson, Vice President of Thin Film Photovolteic Panels, Solarex gave a brief explanation of the growth of BP Solarex that is currently occurring around the world. Mr. Albertson stated that the Research & Development portion of their business will be housed in the shell building.

4. ACTION ITEMS

a. Ratification of Lease Agreement with BP Solarex at 3600 LaGrange Parkway

Mr. Rogers briefly explained that the lease agreement between BP Solarex and the IDA was signed by Chairman Bartlett previously. He stated that the IDA is being asked to ratify that lease today. On a motion by Mr. Berkenkamp and a second by Mr. Nystrom, the ratification of the lease agreement with BP Solarex was approved by unanimous voice vote.

b. Acceptance of Real Estate Sales Agreement with BP Solarex at 3600 LaGrange Parkway

Mr. Rogers stated that the IDA shell building will be sold for \$2.4 million dollars and will close today. On a motion by Mr. Berkenkamp and a second by Mr. Nystrom, the acceptance of the real estate sales agreement with BP Solarex was approved by unanimous voice vote.

c. <u>Resolution Authorizing Transfer of 3600 LaGrange Parkway Sales Proceeds to James City County</u>

Mr. Rogers stated that the proceeds from the sale of the shell building will be held in County accounts as income to the County. On a motion by Mr. Berkenkamp and a second by Mr. Nystrom, the resolution authorizing transfer of the sales proceeds was approved by unanimous voice vote.
