#### 3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

#### a. Treasurer's and Financial Reports

#### a. 2004 Nominating Committee Report

Ms. Hartmann reported that her committee's nominations for Officers for 2004 were Mr. Vincent A. Campana, Jr. for Chairman, Ms. Virginia B. Hartmann for Vice Chair, the County's Economic Development Director for IDA Secretary and the County's Treasurer for IDA Treasurer.

#### 6. ACTION ITEMS

#### a. Election of Officers for 2004

Mr. Campana gave the Chair to Mr. Berkenkamp. On a motion by Mr. Berkenkamp and a second by Mr. Ngo, the nominations for Mr. Vincent A. Campana, Jr. as Chairman, Ms. Virginia B. Hartmann as Vice Chair, the County's Economic Development Director as IDA Secretary and the County's Treasurer as IDA Treasurer were approved by unanimous voice vote. Mr. Berkenkamp then gave the Chair back to Mr. Campana.

#### b. Meeting Calendar for 2004

On a motion by Mr. Bartlett and a second by Mr. Berkenkamp, the proposed 2004 meeting calendar was adopted by unanimous voice vote.

#### 7. PRESENTATION ITEMS

#### a. William & Mary MBA Field Studies Metrics Project Presentation

Mr. Berkenkamp introduced Rich Williams, a member of the William & Mary MBA Field Studies team that worked on developing a fiscal analysis impact model for the IDA. Mr. Williams introduced the Field Studies Team and gave an overview of the team's work plan. He then gave an explanation of how the spreadsheet model was developed and how it works. He explained that the model had been developed so that it would be simple to use. He then answered questions.

Mr. Williams then introduced Chad Chilcot, another member of the Field Studies team, who gave a demonstration of the spreadsheet model. Mr. Chilcot noted that the model is simple to use, customizable, and the user has the ability to update the model with new County budget numbers and demographics as they are available.

The team answered questions. Mr. Williams stated that the team plans to complete the spreadsheet model and user's guide by the end of the fall semester, December 12.

#### b. Sensor Industry SWOT Analysis Presentation

Mr. Taylor introduced John Rhodes, President, Moran, Stahl & Boyer, who made a presentation on the Sensor Industry SWOT analysis which he completed for the IDA. Mr. Rhodes described the objectives of the study. The first objective was to determine what aspects and types of sensor development and manufacturing should be targeted for James City County based on local R&D and industry activity. The second objective was to make general recommendations on next steps to take to capture business as determined in Objective 1. Mr. Rhodes then explained his methodology, which was to generate a profile of the U.S. sensor industry and develop information on sensor companies. Mr. Rhodes gave an overview of the sensor industry, which included its scope and size, types of sensors, sensor applications, types of research organizations involved in sensor research, descriptions of different-sized sensor-related companies, sensor components and the typical manufacturing process. Mr. Rhodes then gave an overview of current sensor activity in the Hampton Roads area. Mr. Rhodes next reviewed his sensor-industry SWOT analysis. He concluded by summarizing his findings and his recommendations for the County.

Mr. Rhodes asked the Directors for their feedback on the analysis and answered questions.

#### 8. ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Campana asked that the reports be postponed until the next meeting.

Mr. Taylor congratulated Mr. Bush, Ms. Barner, and Ms. See for putting together a successful Women and Minority Owned Business Procurement Conference. He also mentioned that he would like to have a project liaison from the IDA appointed to work with the Office of Economic Development on a prospect; Mr. Campana said he would serve in this capacity.

There being no further business Chairman Campana entertained a motion from Ms. Hartmann to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Mr. Bush and approved by unanimous voice vote. The meeting was adjourned at 10:36 a.m.
