Ordinance No. 11

LICENSES: CARNIVALS

Adopted August 3, 1936 -- see volume 4, page 169.

"BE IT ORDAINED, that a County License of \$200.00 per day be required of all persons, firms, companies, corporations who shall hereafter exhibit any performance such as require a State License under Section 153 of the Tax Code of Virginia as amended by Chapter 190 of the Acts of Assembly 1936, and

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no person, firm, company or corporation who violates this ordinance shall be punishable in accordance with Section 153a of the Tax Code of Virginia as amended by Chapter 48 of the Acts of Assembly 1936 and each day's exhibit of any such performance without a license required by this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense and punishable as such."
