

BUILDING PERMITS

Adopted April 7, 1947--see Volume 5, page 37.

"WHEREAS, an ordinance proposed at the last meeting requiring building permits has been duly published.

"THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that every person or corporation, shall, before commencing the construction, repairs, or improvements of any building or structure located within James City County and permanently annexed to the freeholder, if the costs of such construction, repair or improvements shall exceed the sum of \$500.00 shall obtain from the Commissioner of Revenue of James City County a permit in writing signed by the Commissioner and the Commissioner shall issue such permits when the same are required to every person who shall apply therefor and subscribe with reasonable surety the kind and character of the work to be done and the estimated costs thereof and each such permit shall state the matter so described; no fee shall be charged for any such permit.

"Any person violating this ordinance shall be fined the sum not exceeding \$25.00 for each offense.

"This ordinance shall become effective on this date."
