PARKING

"AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF TOANO, JAMES CITY COUNTY, VIRGINIA.

"It shall be unlawful for any person to park any automobile, truck, motorcycle, scooter, or other motor vehicle,
or any animal drawn vehicle, on the northerly side of Route
60 in Toano, Virginia, between the Wayside Inn and the Green
Shingle Inn, or to park any of said vehicles on the southerly
side of Route 60 in Toano, Virginia, in front of the fire
house.

"Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00, and for any second or subsequent conviction, by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00. Any police officer shall have the right to remove any vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance and the person so convicted shall be required to pay the expense of said removal.
