Ordinance No. 27

RECORDING OF PLATS

Adopted September 8, 1953 -- see Volume 5, page 215.

"An Ordinance to fix the charge to be made for the Recordation of Plats.

"In order to defray the cost of providing and maintaining plat books in the Clerk's Office of the City of Williamsburg and County of James City, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of James City County that the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the City of Williamsburg and County of James City shall make the following charges in addition to Clerk's fees authorized by law for all plat offered for recordation in said Clerk's Office:

"Plats which require more than 1/2 a page, 2.50.

"Plats which require more than 1/4 of a page but not more than 1/2, \$1.25.

"Plats which require more than 1/8 of a page but not more than 1/4, \$.75.

"Plats which require 1/8 of a page or less, \$.50.

All amounts received from this source shall be paid into the General Fund of the County of James City and City of Williamsburg, to be divided equally between them, and this Ordinance to be effective upon the adoption of a similar ordinance by the City of Williamsburg.

"Motion duly made and carried that the foregoing ordinance be unanimously adopted."
