

SPEED AT DUNBAR

"AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES AT DUNBAR SECTION, EASTERN STATE HOSPITAL, JAMES CITY COUNTY, VIRGINIA.

"No person shall operate a motor vehicle on the roads situate at Dunbar Section, Eastern State Hospital, James City County, Virginia, which said roads have been designated by the State Department of Highways as Route 322, at a speed in excess of 25 miles per hour, and any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$200.00 or by confinement in jail not exceeding 30 days, either or both. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to all roads, streets, or other ways in said section and to any other portion of State Highway #322 which may later be accepted by the State Department of Highways.

"This ordinance shall be effective as of December 1, 1954."
