

BOATING SAFETY ACT REGULATIONS

RE: Harper Anderson's Progress Report to James City County Supervisors on Codification of County Ordinance (October, 1962)

Section 4-14. "Boating Safety Act Regulations. This item has not been enacted as an ordinance by James City County, but is law by virtue of the authority of Commission of Game and Inland Fisheries, copy was in front of present code; therefore, for purpose of convenience in location, it is suggested that it be incorporated in present code."

Section 62-174.15. Local Regulation.

(a) Any subdivision of this State, may at any time, but only after public notice, make formal application to the Commission for special rules and regulations with reference to the safe and reasonable operation of vessels on any water within its territorial limits and shall set forth therein the reasons which makes such special rules or regulations necessary or appropriate.

(b) The Commission is hereby authorized to make special rules and regulation with reference to the safe and reasonable operation of vessels on any waters within the territorial limits of any subdivision of this State.
