

*Ordinance No. 39*

"AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING A PERMIT TO BUILD OR CONSTRUCT  
WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of Supervisors  
of James City County, Virginia, it is deemed necessary to adopt  
this ordinance in accordance with Section 15-8, Code of Virginia.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JAMES CITY  
COUNTY, VIRGINIA, AS FOLLOWS, to-wit:

SECTION I. Permits-When Required:

Any person, firm, corporation, or association, will,  
before commencing the construction of, repairs to, or improve-  
ments on, any building or structure located within James City  
County, Virginia, and permanently annexed to the freeholder,  
obtain from the Commissioner of Revenue for James City County,  
Virginia, a permit in writing and signed by the Commissioner of  
Revenue.

SECTION II. Issuance:

When the Commissioner of Revenue is satisfied that  
the application for a permit complies with the provisions of  
this ordinance, he will cause a permit to be issued for the  
construction of, repairs to, or improvements on the building  
or structure.

SECTION III. Amount of Fee:

When permits are required, every person, firm, corpora-  
tion, or association shall apply, and with reasonable surety  
state the kind and character of the work to be done and the esti-  
mated costs thereof, and will be charged a fee on the following

basis of estimated costs:

## SECTION IV. Penalty:

Any person, firm, corporation, or association violating this ordinance shall be fined the sum not to exceed \$25.00 for each offense."
