WILD ANIMAL ORDINANCE

115

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to bring into or keep any wild animal (classed as ferae naturae), within the County of James City, Virginia, and any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding three hundred dollars or confinement in jail not exceeding thirty days, or both, in the discretion of the jury or of the Court trying the case without a jury.
