#### AN ORDINANCE TO

#### RENEW CONTINENTAL CABLEVISION

### OF VIRGINIA, INC.'S FRANCHISE CERTIFICATE

- WHEREAS, Continental Cablevision of Virginia, Inc., ("Continental") is the grantee of a nonexclusive franchise to construct and operate a cable communications system in the County under a Franchise Certificate effective June 8, 1981; and
- WHEREAS. the County and Continental agreed to extend the Franchise Certificate nine years by an Amendment to the Franchise Certificate dated July 2, 1990; and
- WHEREAS, the County's Cable Television Advisory Committee recommends approval of the five year extension to Continental's franchise; and
- WHEREAS, the County and the Cable Communications Administrator desire to extend the term of the existing franchise for an additional five years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of James City County, Virginia that:

- 1. The County's Franchise Certificate, as amended, with Continental Cablevision of Virginia, is hereby renewed for 15 years from the date of this Ordinance.
- 2. The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Second Amendment to Franchise Certificate with Continental Cablevision of Virginia.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its adoption.
