


Application of Virginia Electric and Power Company for a wetlands permit to perform construction of a double circuit steel transmission tower and the stringing of the related conductors in the wetlands of Skiffes Creek.

Mr. C. A. Sherry explained the project indicating that most of the work would be done above the marsh rather than in it. The only work to be done directly in the marsh would be the pulling of lead lines across Skiffes Creek.

Mr. Sherry said that as far as VEPCO could tell, no damage would occur to the marsh but if something did happen, then VEPCO would probably take responsibility for rehabilitating the marsh. After a general discussion, the meeting was recessed to reconvene at the call of the chairman.
