D. NEW BUSINESS

1. W-11-88 T.R. Vermillion

Mr. Farmer stated that Mr. William B. Ellen on behalf of Mr. T.R. Vermillion had applied for a wetlands permit to dredge approximately 2000 cubic yards of mud and silt by mechanically removing by dragline and to construct a floating covered boat shed providing 20 small boat slips extending approximately 198 feet channelward of mean high water and creating a 200' x 100' disposal area on site at the Jamestown Marina. Mr. Farmer further stated that staff recommends that approval be granted with the following conditions:

1. Site plan approval and any necessary building permits must be obtained from the County prior to commencement of work.
2. Approved erosion and sedimentation control measures and permits must be obtained for the disposal area prior to dredging.
3. This permit shall expire on June 8, 1989.

Mr. Lindsey opened the public hearing.

Mr. Vermillion stated there was nothing additional that could be added to Mr. Farmer's statement.

There was a brief discussion regarding the methods and the areas being considered presently and in the future.

Mr. Lindsey closed the public hearing.

Mr. Apperson motioned to grant the permit with the staff recommendation.


The motion was carried unanimously.
