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

Joanna – it is my understanding that our inspections group has either provided this or is working to provide this information. Joe says that Rick gave him this information for our inspectors to look at to see if they would be inactivated from your end.

As far as the blanks in your excel spreadsheet, I can help there...but quite honestly I can't for the life of me figure out why there are some inconsistencies between our access database and the excel spreadsheet you just provided. Anyways do this on your "blanks". (Note: blank means it has a BMP # but no information at all):

CC036 is blank but should be Whitings Funeral Home, 7005 Pocahontas Trail, dry swale. Bond is not released, so inactivated is correct.  
 CC037 is blank but should be Whitings Funeral Home, BMP #2. Bond is not released, so inactivated is correct.  
 Delete record PC043. I did so from our database. This number may be used later though.  
 Delete record YC002. I did so from our database. This number may be used later though.

Delete record YC010. I did so from our database. This number may be used later though.

YR 003 is blank but should be Farm Fresh Fuel Express, 115 Norge Lane. It is a manufactured BMP unit in the new fuel area. Bond is released so it should be activated on your list.

Settlers Mill, MC028 is definitely 'activated'

The Stormwater Division database contains a "status" field that refers to whether or not Stormwater should be inspecting a particular BMP. Below is the key as to what active and inactivated represents in our system. Please review and revise the attached spreadsheet so I can update the database. I know recently there has been some question as to what BMPs should be inspected and by whom in the Stonehouse area. I hope that once this list has been entered in our database it will resolve any future inspection conflicts. I realize this is not a top priority, but this information is essential for us to map out our inspection areas, so if you could get this back to me as soon as humanly possible that would be great! ☺
