
CASE NO. SUP-22-93. DEBORAH J. HICKS - MANUFACTURED HOME

Any replacement shall require a new permit from the Board of Supervisors. If the permit is not exercised, it shall become void one year from the date of approval.2. The manufactured home shall be skirted and meet the requirements of the Department of Housing and Urban Development Manufactured Home Construction and Safety Standards.3. The existing manufactured home shall be removed within 30 days of the placement of the new unit.
