

RESOLUTION

STREET NAME CHANGE: NEWS ROAD TO OLD NEWS ROAD

WHEREAS, Section 19-54 (B) of the James City County Subdivision Ordinance provides for street names to be changed upon approval by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, Revised road configurations in the Ironbound/News Road area have necessitated street name changes; and

WHEREAS, A resolution passed by the Board of Supervisors on March 23, 1999, named the extension of News Road, connecting News Road and Ironbound Road, "News Road" and

WHEREAS, The street located behind the Monticello Marketplace is currently named News Road; and

WHEREAS, There are currently two roads named News Road; and


WHEREAS, The proposed street name change has been discussed with the Virginia Department of Transportation, Fire Department, Planning Division, and the Williamsburg Post Office, and these agencies have found it acceptable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of James City County, Virginia, does hereby approve renaming the street, News Road, located behind the Monticello Marketplace, to "Old News Road."
