RESOLUTION

STORM DEBRIS COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL

- WHEREAS, residents of the County have accumulated significant amounts of storm debris due to the extraordinary severity of the Christmas 1998 ice storm; and
- WHEREAS, the County experienced unplanned and unbudgeted overtime charges during the debris removal program; and
- WHEREAS, additional unbudgeted expenses have been paid to other jurisdictions and private companies to collect and dispose of storm debris from residential neighborhoods; and
- WHEREAS, the County's FY 99 Operating Budget, as amended, does not contain sufficient funding for such a program and will need to be amended.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of James City County, Virginia, authorizes the following additional appropriations of funds from the FY 98 Undesignated Fund Balance:

Overtime costs for County employees performing emergency activities during the storm and overtime costs incurred in completing the January/February debris removal efforts; distributed to departments as approved by the County Administrator based on payroll information
