WHEREAS, Project Discovery is one of the most effective drop-out prevention programs in the nation; and


WHEREAS, Project Discovery's efforts assist economically disadvantaged and first generation college students in their preparation for post secondary education; and

WHEREAS, since 1986, the Virginia General Assembly has consistently appropriated funds for the operation of Project Discovery programs; and


WHEREAS, since 1986, Project Discovery programs have been implemented in forty-eight jurisdictions, including James City County and the Community Action Agency; and

WHEREAS, of the 4,000 students served statewide each year, 99.7 percent remain in school through graduation, and for the 1998-99 school year, 79 percent of the Project Discovery seniors enrolled in college.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of James City County, Virginia, does hereby proclaim January 18, 2000, as Project Discovery Day and call this observance to the attention of all citizens.
