POLICE AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR PROGRAM

WILLIAMSBURG COMMUNITY HEALTH FOUNDATION GRANT

- WHEREAS, in early 2001 the Police Department established an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) Program partnership with the Fire Department that is designed to further reduce the time required to provide lifesaving AED assistance to victims of sudden cardiac arrest; and
- WHEREAS, the Police Department initiated this program with five (5) AEDs acquired through Bruton Parish Church and County Innovation Grant funding; and
- WHEREAS, the Williamsburg Community Health Foundation has awarded the Police Department a \$20,000 grant to acquire and deploy up to 12 additional AEDs as the next phase of a plan to ultimately equip all Police vehicles with such devices.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of James City County, Virginia, hereby authorizes the acceptance of the Health Foundation grant and the following appropriation amendments:
