

**RESOLUTION**


**COLONIAL COMMUNITY CRIMINAL JUSTICE BOARD APPOINTMENT – POLICE CHIEF**

WHEREAS, the Police Chief is required by the Code of Virginia to be appointed to the CCCJB; and


WHEREAS, members serve three-year terms.
