RESOLUTION

GRANTING AN APPEAL ON JCC RE TAX PARCEL NO. 3720500035

- WHEREAS, Joseph J. and Patricia M. Wysocki, (the "Applicants" and "Owners") have appeared before the Chesapeake Bay Board of James City County (the "Board") on June 9, 2010 appealing a Notice of Violation (CBV-10-007) dated April 30, 2010, ordering removal of the patio and restoration of the Resource Protection Area (RPA) on the property identified as JCC RE Tax Parcel No. 3720500035 and further identified as 113 Ridge Crossing, in the Ford's Colony Subdivision (the "Property") and;
- WHEREAS, the Board has listened to the arguments presented and has carefully considered all evidence entered into the record.
- NOW, THEREFORE, following a public hearing, the Chesapeake Bay Board of James City County by a majority vote of its members FINDS that all of the following conditions have been met:
 - 1. The hardship is not generally shared by other properties in the vicinity;
 - 2. The Chesapeake Bay, its tributaries and other properties in the vicinity will not be adversely affected: and
 - 3. The appellant acquired the property in good faith and the hardship is not self-inflicted.
- THEREFORE, the Chesapeake Bay Board of James City County is granting the appeal filed by *Joseph J. and Patricia M. Wysocki on May 11, 2010* and overturning the *April 30, 2010* Notice of Violation issued by the James City County Environmental Division with the following condition:

A Sensitive Area Activity Application for the patio must be submitted and considered by the Chesapeake Bay Board at the next regularly scheduled meeting.
