GRANT AWARD – STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM GRANT – \$11,530

WHEREAS, the James City County Fire Department's Division of Emergency Management has been awarded a State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grant in the amount of \$11,530 from the Virginia Department of Emergency Management (VDEM) using funds from the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) 2012 Homeland Security Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used to increase the safety, preparedness and resiliency of County residents through citizen-focused programs including Community Emergency Response Teams (CERT), Neighborhood Watch, Volunteers In Police Service (VIPS), and the Citizen Corps Council; and
