## JAMES CITY SERVICE AUTHORITY **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING** WATER AND SEWER **SERVICE RATE**

The Board of Directors of the James City Service Authority will hold a Public Hearing on April 26, 2016, at 7 p.m., in the Building F Board Room, County Government Center, 101-F Mounts Bay Road, James City County, Virginia, to consider the following proposed changes to Section 32, General Rate Policy and Rate Schedule, Regulations Governing Utility Service.

### B. Wastewater Charges

5. Retell service rates. The wastewater service charge shall be based on usage from a metered water source where available. For wastewater service on an unmetered water source a meter size equivalent shall be used, based upon an estimated charge.

(a) Metered water source.

Charge for all collection and treatment of wastewater

(1) Fixed Charge- Each customer bill shall include a Fixed Charge based upon the size of the meter serving the customer. The Fixed Charge for each billing cycle shall be calculated based on the quarterly fixed charge chart below. This Fixed Charge is for expenses associated with operating and maintaining the wastewater collection system.

Commercial condensate discharge shall be billed annually at the current wastewater collection meteral trails service rate. The bill shall be based on a condensate volume estimate prepared by the customer or customer's designated representative and approved by JCSA Engineering.

- Billing and account charges. The following charges shall be assessed for any customer billed by the Authority.
- 5. Meter test deposit. A test of a water meter shall be done at the request of a water customer upon payment of a meter test deposit as defined in Section 11. If the meter is found to be 3 percent or more fast then the deposit shall be refunded. If inoperable or 25 percent or more slow, the deposit shall be credited against a revised billing. The deposit shall be determined by meter size, as follows:
