

RESOLUTION

FEDERAL GRANT AWARD – BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP – \$25,972

WHEREAS, the James City County Police Department has been awarded a Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) grant from the Office of Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance for \$25,972 (\$12,986 federal funds; \$12,986 local match); and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a match of \$12,986, which is available in the Grant Match Account; and

WHEREAS, the funds are to be used to purchase approximately 26 new and replacement bulletproof vests for officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of James City County, Virginia, hereby authorizes the acceptance of this grant and the following appropriation amendment to the Special Projects/Grants Fund:


