

RESOLUTION

HAMPTON ROADS HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN ADOPTION

WHEREAS, James City County Fire Department is seeking the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approval of a Hazard Mitigation Plan that recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, an adopted Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, James City County Fire Department fully participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region III officials have reviewed the "2017 Hampton Roads Hazard Mitigation Plan Update" and approved it contingent upon the official adoption of the participating governments and entities.


