BIRTHPLACE OF AMERICA TRAIL STUDY – RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC) of the Hampton Roads Transportation Planning Organization (HRTPO) created an ad-hoc committee to consider opportunities for trails to connect the existing Jamestown terminus of the Capital Trail with points in Suffolk and Hampton; and

WHEREAS, the work of the Committee supports multiple strategies identified in the Economic Development, Parks & Recreation and Transportation sections of the Comprehensive Plan “Toward 2035: Leading the Way” adopted in 2015; and


WHEREAS, the Committee solicited public input and evaluated several potential trail alignments for cost, feasibility and demand; and

WHEREAS, the Committee identified an alignment which is compatible with the adopted Regional Bike Facilities Plan, the adopted James City County Pedestrian Accommodations Master Plan and the Pocahontas Trail corridor vision; and

WHEREAS, this preferred alignment is supported by the Historic Triangle Bicycle Advisory Committee; and


WHEREAS, the Committee has identified this project and the designated preferred alignments as the Birthplace of America Trail.
