- WHEREAS, the Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC) of the Hampton Roads Transportation Planning Organization (HRTPO) created an ad-hoc committee to consider opportunities for trails to connect the existing Jamestown terminus of the Capital Trail with points in Suffolk and Hampton; and
- WHEREAS, the work of the Committee supports multiple strategies identified in the Economic Development, Parks & Recreation and Transportation sections of the Comprehensive Plan "Toward 2035: Leading the Way" adopted in 2015; and
