CONTINUATION GRANT AWARD - POLICING IN THE 21ST CENTURY -

TECHNOLOGY INITIATIVE - \$12,444

WHEREAS, the James City County Police Department has been awarded a continuation grant for Policing in the 21st Century - Technology Initiative from the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) for \$12,444; and

WHEREAS, \$11,200 is awarded from the Commonwealth of Virginia and \$1,244 will be provided through an in-kind match; and

WHEREAS, the funds are to be used to purchase the Freedom application to allow authorized employees access to the Records Management Systems and the Computer Aided Dispatch programs via mobile phone and tablet.


