## RESOLUTION

## CASE NO. CBE-17-048. 7515 OAK COVE ROAD

## GRANTING AN EXTENSION OF AN EXCEPTION

- WHEREAS, Jennifer Privette (the "Applicant") has requested an extension of the exception granted by the Chesapeake Bay Board of James City County (the "Board") on March 8, 2017. The exception request is for use of the Resource Protection Area (the "RPA") on a parcel of property identified as James City County Real Estate Tax Parcel No. 1910100013 and further identified as 7515 Oak Cove Road (the "Property") as set forth in the application CBE-17-048, for the construction of a room addition associated with an existing single-family dwelling; and
- WHEREAS, the Board has listened to the arguments presented and has carefully considered all evidence entered into the record.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chesapeake Bay Board of James City County, Virginia, following a public hearing on March 8, 2017, by a majority vote of its members FINDS that:
  - 1. The exception request is the minimum necessary to afford relief.
  - 2. Granting the exception will not confer upon the Applicant any special privileges denied by Chapter 23, Chesapeake Bay Preservation, of the James City County Code, to other property owners similarly situated in the vicinity.
  - 3. The exception request will be in harmony with the purpose and intent of Chapter 23 of the James City County Code, and is not of substantial detriment to water quality.
  - 4. The exception request is not based on conditions or circumstances that are self-created or self-imposed, nor does the request arise from conditions or circumstances either permitted or non-conforming that are related to adjacent parcels.
  - 5. Reasonable and appropriate conditions are hereby imposed, as set forth below, which will prevent the exception request from causing a degradation of water quality.
  - 6. In granting this exception, the following conditions are hereby imposed to prevent this exception request from causing degradation of water quality:
    - a. The applicant must obtain all other necessary federal, state and local permits required for the project; and
    - Surety of \$250 will be required in a form acceptable to the County Attorney's office; and
    - c. This exception request approval shall become null and void if construction has not begun by March 14, 2019; and
    - d. Written requests for an extension to an exception shall be submitted to the Engineering and Resource Protection Division no later than six weeks prior to the expiration date.
